Jack & Jill Playschool are included in the new Government Funding program which allows accessible, affordable child care for your family. Please read carefully through our program's tuition breakdown to understand how this benefits you.

3AM & 3/4PM Class Direct Withdrawal Schedule

Alberta's Government Funding program provides Jack & Jill Playschool with \$75.00 for each student enrolled in the 3 year old program per month. A breakdown of the reduced amount is below.

September Automatic Withdrawal

\$267.80 (includes first & last month's tuition fees)
 \$ 30.00 (first semester cleaning fee)
 - \$150.00 (Government funding for first & last month's tuition fees)
= \$147.80 Withdrawal (first & last month's tuition fees)

Monthly Tuition Automatic Withdrawal 2024 (x 3)

October 1st to December 1st
 \$133.90 (monthly tuition)
 - \$75.00 (Government funding)
= \$58.90 Monthly Withdrawal

January 2025 Tuition Automatic Withdrawal (x 1)

\$133.90 (monthly tuition)
 \$30.00 (second semester cleaning fee)
 - \$75.00 (Government funding)
= \$88.90 ONE MONTH WITHDRAW

Monthly Tuition Automatic Withdrawal 2025 (x 4)

February 1st to May 1st
 \$133.90 (monthly tuition)
 - \$75.00 (Government funding)
= \$58.90 Monthly Withdrawal

Registration Fee (due upon confirmation of acceptance)

\$100.00

Fundraising Commitment

\$200.00/student

A minimum of one month's written notice is required when withdrawing from Jack & Jill Playschool. In order to withdraw from the program, notice must be provided by the first calendar day of the month. For example, for withdrawal from the program on November 1st, notice must be provided by October 1st. Notice will be submitted to the registrar by email at registrar@jandjplayschool.ca. In addition we require the Withdrawal From (brightwheel) to be completed which can be found in your classroom folder in Google Drive.

Withdrawal notices will not be accepted for the month of June. May is the last month to withdraw, meaning withdrawal notice would have to be provided by April 1st.
